Collective Bargaining by County Employees Act

UNFAIR LABOR PRACTICE COMPLAINT

Under the <u>Collective Bargaining by County Employees Act</u> ("COBCA"), C.R.S. § 8-3.3-101 *et seq.*, a complaint alleging unfair labor practices may be filed with the Division of Labor Standards and Statistics ("Division") by a county employee, a covered county, or an employee organization. C.R.S. § 8-3.3-115 states the specific "unfair labor practices" prohibited by COBCA and generally includes failure to comply with any requirements stated in the statute. COBCA Rule 5 outlines the process for filing an unfair labor practice complaint, as well as the procedures for investigation, determination, and remedies in the event of a violation. Although some employment-related activities may be viewed as unfair, they may not fall within the Division's jurisdiction. For guidance, refer to the <u>COBCA Rules</u> and <u>INFO #15B</u>.
