Wage Complaint Form

The Colorado Division of Labor Standards and Statistics may assist employees who work in Colorado with the recovery of unpaid wages that are within the Division's jurisdiction. Our new online complaint form is available for current and former Colorado private sector employees who did not receive their wages from a current or former employer. The Division's process is a free service available to employees, regardless of immigration status.

Get Started

Start by answering a few preliminary questions to help us determine if your wage complaint is within our jurisdiction to investigate. If it is, you will be directed to our online claim portal.

Create an Account

1. If you are a first time user, please select the "First Time User" button to create an account.
2. Enter your first name, last name and email address then submit.
3. You will receive a welcome email in order to complete the registration process. Once you click on the confirmation link, you will be required to change your password.
4. If you are an employer, enter in the employer community ID located on the "Notice of Complaint."

How to Submit a Claim

1. To submit an online claim, click on the First Time User Button to create a new user name and password. If you already have an account, use the log in button instead.
2. For new users, you will receive a welcome email with a link to create your password.

File a Complaint or Send Your Response

1. After you have logged in, you can select “Wage Complaint Submission” under Available Forms to file your wage complaint.
2. Answer all questions accurately, and provide all necessary information to support your complaint. Incomplete forms and missing information will delay the process.

Employees and employers can also file a response to a letter from the Division using the online portal.

Claim Details

To view the details of the claim, please click on the Claim Details tab (see diagram 3). This tab shows you a snapshot of the claim information. For employees, to see the entire complaint form you submitted, please click on the “View Your Complaint Form” button at the top right of the screen. For employers, please see the “Notice of Complaint” sent to you for further details about the claim.

Next Steps

The Division will contact you when we start our investigation or need more information from you. Promptly respond to any communications from the Division, and continue to provide any new information relevant to your wage complaint. Please be aware this process may take several months to complete, and it may be some time before the Division contacts you.

Our Process

You may pursue your wage complaint through our process, or may elect to go to court instead; the Division process is not required in order to pursue the matter in court. However, if at any time you pursue the matter in court, you may not use the Division process.
