# What's Happening in the Rural Consortium

Christy Gonzales shared an overview of current events and projects occurring in the CRWC – see attached PowerPoint.

### Brian Vogt, CEO Denver Botanic Gardens

Denver Botanic Gardens' visionary CEO, Brian Vogt, shared a bit about his background including information about his time working with local non-profits, experience leading the Colorado Office of Economic Development and International Trade, Director of the Department of Local Affairs and the last six years as CEO of Denver Botanic Gardens. Brian shared, "We are creating the world we see in front of us." He also shared that the Botanic Gardens team is working to inspire people about becoming citizen scientists, teaching them about the ecosystems that make up Colorado and their importance, and helping them to observe their world a little bit differently.

### **CRWC Workforce Development Board Bylaws**

### **Rural Consortium Regional Planning Process**

Clarke Becker welcomed John Flannigan to the meeting and provided an overview of the *planning regions* that exist in the CRWC. He shared that the *plans* for the planning regions must be complete by May 2<sup>nd</sup>. He clarified that the development of the plan is not a Workforce Development Board responsibility; however, within each of the planning areas – he would expect the local sub-area board members to be engaged in the discussions.

Brian Pool, North Highland, joined the meeting and provided details about his role in the planning process. Brian and his co-worker Lauren Croucher will be facilitating the discussions and preparing the actual plans, based off the planning meetings. The plan is to meet with employers, education, economic and workforce development folks from each planning region.

### **State Demography Office**

Chris Akers, Economist, and Jimi Foster, Labor Market Information, provided a thorough overview of the current demographics of Colorado, as they relate to workforce. Chris shared that 138.4 million jobs are in place in the United States, indicating that we have reached the level defined as a *full recovery* of the recession. ### **Workforce Innovation & Opportunity Act Committees**

The CRWC board decided to proceed with the WIOA CRWC Youth Committee. Additional committees will be considered as the regional plans and PY16 WIOA plans are developed. Danielle Kirkpatrick agreed to take on the role of *chair* of the Youth Committee.

## **Cannabis Industry Panel**

Andrew Freedman, State Director of Marijuana Coordination, and Tyler Henson, President, Cannabis Chamber, shared an overview of their positions within the cannabis industry in Colorado. Tyler shared that the Chamber focuses on the issues that concern the business of cannabis, while promoting businesses through the statewide network of dispensaries, cultivators, manufacturers, laboratories, distributors, realtors, packaging manufacturers, advertising professionals and the media. Andrew shared that he was appointed by the Governor as the Director of Marijuana Coordination. He discussed his mission of ensuring the efficient and effective regulation of Colorado's retail and medical marijuana while promoting public health, maintaining public safety, and keeping marijuana out of the hands of children.
