Summary	Transformational investment to 20-30 regions across the country that want to revitalize their economies. These regions will have the opportunity to grow new regional industry clusters or scale existing ones through planning, infrastructure, innovation and entrepreneurship, workforce development, access to capital, and more.	EDA's most flexible program. A wide range of technical, planning, workforce development, entrepreneurship, and public works and infrastructure projects are eligible for funding under this program.
Special considerations	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● At least \$100 million to support coal communities ● One BIG project included that goes beyond the funding scope of a regular EAA grant (i.e. \$15M Broadband project) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● At least \$200 million to support coal communities (\$23.6M in Denver 10 state region) ● Jobs requirement

Summary	Help communities that have been hardest hit by challenges facing the travel, tourism and outdoor recreation sectors to invest in infrastructure, workforce or other projects to support the recovery of the industry and economic resilience of the community in the future.	Collaborative skills training systems and programs, especially reaching historically underserved populations. These systems and partnerships create and implement industry-led training programs, designed to provide skills for and connect unemployed or underemployed workers to existing and emerging job opportunities.
Special considerations	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Destination Marketing not allowed ● Economic diversification considered 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Need a designated private sector employer partner who will hire workforce coming out of program. ● Equipment, building leases and wraparound services allowed ● Building construction not allowed

Match requirement	0%	0% Those coming in with match will be more competitive.
Summary	Support the needs of Tribal Governments and Indigenous communities. A wide range of technical, planning, workforce development, entrepreneurship, and public works and infrastructure projects are eligible for funding under this program.	Research and Networks Grants to invest in research that assesses the effectiveness of EDA's programs, and provides support for stakeholder communities around key EDA initiatives.
Special considerations	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● EDA-eligible tribal and indigenous communities (or their direct partners only) ● Jobs requirement 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Designed more for EDA research partners & higher ed ● Intended to get new, non-traditional partners into the EDA network to inform it.
