

PUA - Pandemic Unemployment Assistance

Phase 1

If you **did not** use all 39 weeks of PUA benefits as of 12/26/20, then you are in **Phase 1**. When you log into the MyUI+ application on or after 2/1/21, you can reopen your PUA claim and certify for available weeks after 12/26/20.

Phase 2

If you **did use** all 39 weeks of PUA benefits as of 12/26/20, then you will be in **Phase 2**.

Standard State Unemployment Claim

Phase 1

If you **exhausted** your state unemployment benefits, then you moved to the **Federal Pandemic Emergency Unemployment Compensation (PEUC)** program, and **had not exhausted your PEUC balance** as of 12/26/20, you are in **Phase 1**. When you log into the MyUI+ application on or after 2/1/21, you can reopen your PEUC claim and certify for available weeks after 12/26/20.

Phase 2

If you **exhausted** your state unemployment benefits, then **moved to PEUC and exhausted your PEUC benefits** as of 12/26/20, you will be in **Phase 2**.

Phase 1

If you **exhausted** your state unemployment benefits, then you **moved to PEUC** and exhausted your PEUC benefits, then moved to **State Extended Benefits (SEB)**, and then filed for PUA prior to 12/26/20, you may be eligible to reopen your PUA claim under **Phase 1**.

Future Phases

If you **exhausted** your state unemployment benefits, you received PUA benefits before moving to PEUC, additional programming will be required to handle your claim. You will be included in a **future phase**.

Phase 1

If you **exhausted** your state unemployment benefits, then you **moved to PEUC** and exhausted PEUC benefits, **moved to State Extended Benefits (SEB)**, and then filed for PUA prior to 12/26/20, you may be eligible to reopen your PUA claim under **Phase 1**.
